The reports given included those from our new Treasurer, Jeff N, who has made progress in establishing ways for the GSRC to receive donations via PayPal. We have \$6.00 in our account from test deposits. Our primary initial spending plan will be for our Committee's website.

The Co-Webmasters presented a report which outlined the features that we seek for our GSR Committee website, overall cost range and three main choices for hosting plans. We have done a lot of research on these features and plans. There was some discussion about possibly creating a Tech Subcommittee to develop content for the website pages, in alignment with the GSRC Group Conscience.

The Phone Tech Committee report was made by Heidi, and there were questions asked which she addressed.

The WSC Planning Committee report, given by the Chair, Jessica, likewise elicited numerous questions about the WSC 2020 costs, location, virtual platforms, Topics of Concern Survey, and deadlines.

The Fundraising Information Subcommittee (FISC) reported about the Fundraising Strategies Packet, Version 9, a document developed since January 2020 to assist Groups and their GSRs to raise money for sending their GSRs to the WSC. The Motion to approve Version 9 passed after friendly amendments, discussion and voting. The Packet was emailed to GSRs today.

A fun and timely fundraising suggestion was proposed and accepted to have a "Virtual Picnic" where members donate money based on items that they would bring to a picnic, as if it were a face-to-face picnic.
